Challenges Overcame: Lee-Ann survived depression through therapy and is ready to assist others struggling with it








WELCOME NDLOVU

His work is also an outreach for young people receive the Gospel of Christ. Welcome also conducts the Walk thru the Bible OtLive and discipleship Programs. His work alleviate poverty through the soup kitchen and delivery of food parcels to the needy. Welcome conducts his work in schools and churches.

Challenges Overcame: The main challenge that Welcome has is the lack of support staff to run his projects. He has, however, managed to encourage some young people to join him on voluntary basis but lack of donor funding makes the turnover of the young people very quick.
